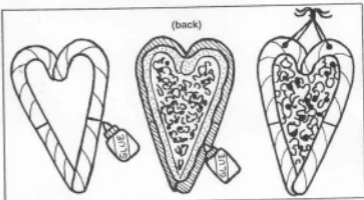


Making the Basic Candy Cane

1. Reproduce the candy cane tops (page 69) and the candy cane bottoms (page 70) on white construction paper.
2. Cut out all pieces. Glue the top to the bottom using the glue tab.
3. Color every other stripe red.
4. Option: use red paint, glitter, or blush to color the stripes.



A Sweet Frame - Up

1. Make two basic candy canes.
2. Place them flat with the hooks overlapping and the ends overlapping to make a heart shape.
3. Glue the overlapping areas.
4. Glue the heart to a large piece of construction paper and instruct the students to draw or write inside the heart.



Use as a frame for:
 a child's photo
 student art work
 holiday stories

See - through Hearts

Materials: ✂️

1. 1 basic candy cane as instructed above.
2. 2 pieces of wax paper approximately 12 inches long.
3. Grated crayon in holiday colors, glitter, foil confetti, etc.
4. hair dryer
5. yarn and hole punch

Instructions:

1. Place one sheet of wax paper on a piece of plain paper.
2. Sprinkle the grated crayon, glitter, confetti, etc. onto the wax paper.
3. Cover with the second piece of wax paper.
4. Point the hair dryer down at the wax paper and use high heat to melt the crayon, etc fusing the two sheets of wax paper.
5. Place the candy cane over the wax paper and trim to fit.
6. Glue the wax paper to the back of the candy heart.
7. Punch a hole in the top and use yarn to hang them around the room.
